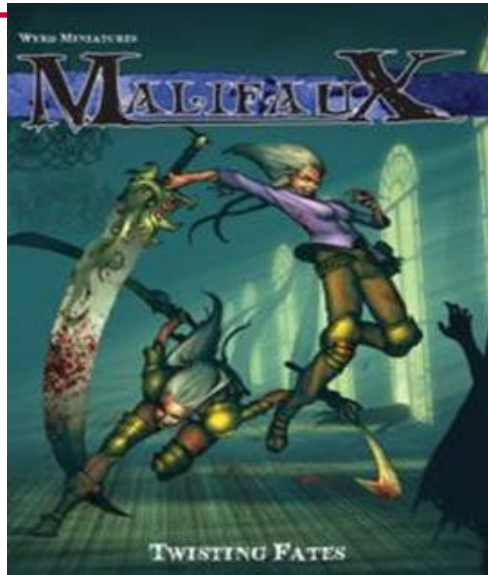

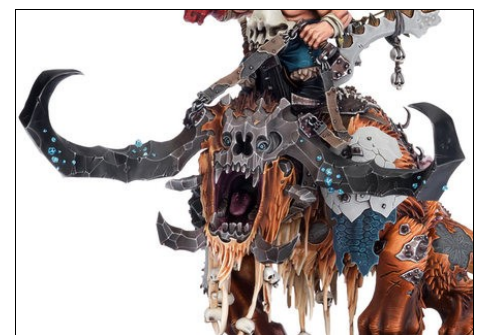
Warhammer Fantasy: Ogre Kingdoms

Tabletop miniature gaming has been a hobby of mine for many years now, but things have changed over the years. Starting out with games like Warhammer Fantasy and Lord of the Rings, the skirmish miniature game never really occurred to me as an option. As time went on though, more and more of this skirmish games emerged and now the market is filled with them.

In this month's newsletter I would like to share with you some of your options as a skirmish gamer.

MERCS— Mercs is a sci-fi

skirmish game set in a not too distant future where governments have failed and corporations have taken over. Your role? To play as a squad of mercs() and stop the other Megacorp from taking your territory...or to steal theirs! Check them out at www.mercsminis.com

Pulp City— Like super heroes, the 80's, and clever spoofs on your favorite spandex wearing supers? Well this is the game for you! Taking place in 1984, you play as a team of either Heroes or Villians fighting throughout Pulp City. Take your pick of models from genetically enhanced monkeys, tech based heroes, invading aliens, and much more! And the best part? The game can be played with as little as 2 miniatures per team!

Malifaux: Bringing together many popular genres(Horror, Steam punk, Victorian, and Western to name a few) Malifaux sets up 2 players to fight their crews, each led by a master, for different schemes and strategies . The game centers around a card mechanic that replaces dice and is actually very nice due to the fact that you get a "control hand" that allows you to cheat fate and change your flip.
